

Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Bride's Room).

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

Ignatian Spirituality:

In a conversation with members of the Jesuit order, Pope Francis said the life situations of everyday Catholics aren't black and white, but rather vary on a spectrum of gray. Because people's lives are complex, the Pope stressed the need for the Church to teach seminarians more about spiritual discernment. He cautioned that many priests can't relate to or accompany the people they counsel, since they haven't been properly formed.

We as lay people also need to be formed in Godly decision making, so that we can learn to make decisions based on where God calls us. Fortunately for us, God, through St. Ignatius, has given us the Spiritual Exercises to teach us discernment.

A Bit of History



On May 20, 2025, the Catholic Church and the whole Christian world will remember with gratitude and joy the opening of the Council of Nicaea in 325.

The great gift of this first ecumenical council was the Nicene Creed, professed by Christians every Sunday throughout the world.

The late Pope Francis wrote, "The Council of Nicaea is a milestone in the Church's history. The celebration of its anniversary invites Christians to unite in a hymn of praise and thanksgiving to the Holy Trinity and in particular to Jesus Christ, the Son of God, 'consubstantial with the Father', who revealed to us this mystery of love."

When the Church celebrates the 1700th anniversary of the Creed, we will have a new Holy Father, and we will profess with him, in every church throughout the world, the faith that unites us as disciples of Jesus Christ throughout the centuries.


