

#### **Sunday Reflection**

#### **Judgment and Love**

"Oh, well. I'm going to hell anyway, right?"
I have a few family members and friends who are not practicing Catholics who say this to me from time to time. It's always spoken in a teasing manner, with a wink and a shoulder shrug, usually to explain away some sort of minor misbehavior they feel guilty about.

It saddens me that Christians have somehow gained this reputation as a people who judge, who condemn. I think in part it stems from a misunderstanding on the part of unchurched people (and lots of churched ones, too) regarding what constitutes "judging." It is absolutely not "judging" someone to disagree with a personal decision, whatever that decision may be, or to decline from participating in that decision. We all have functioning consciences; we are all supposed to discern the moral goodness of any action before we take it. But it is judging someone if we allow their decisions to impact how we treat them.

Today's Gospel is an invitation for us to consider how we engage with people who disagree with us — or maybe even actively dislike us. Much is said these days of the "culture wars." I certainly don't disagree that it can often feel like you're fighting a war when you're trying to live as the Church teaches. The forces against you often seem overwhelming and nefarious. And guess what? They are.

But we need to remember who the enemy really is. The enemy is not other children of God, even if they are children of God who are actively promoting ideas that are wrong. Perhaps these people are misguided and mistaken. Perhaps they are misled by the devil. Have we not all been misled by him at some point? We must interact lovingly with people who think differently and live differently from us. The Christian life absolutely demands it.

He clung to nothing, yet his Father gifted him with abundant graces, which he gave away to us. Jesus loves us now and always. His death was the beginning of a whole new reality and eternal life. In the Spiritual Exercises, we learn how to pray through Jesus' life using our senses and imagination so we can be more present to Christ.

#### **Venerable Mary Angeline Teresa** (5 of 12)

Mother Angeline was explicit about what she thought a home for the aged should be: "A modern home for the aging should be a combination of one's own home, a residential hotel, medical and nursing services, rehabilitation, interesting activities, recreational programs, nutrition – this latter is very important – and spiritual religious services. It should strive to satisfy the personal, social and spiritual needs of each resident."

Mother Angeline was a pioneer in gerontology. She explained her vision:

"Throughout the past forty years the objective of the Carmelite Sisters for the Aged and Infirm has always been to meet the needs of the elderly according to the times. But these needs do change. The Carmelites, other groups and the public have...adapted their programs to meet these changing needs.

"Hopefully, they will continue to do so in the future, with more and more creative and innovative programs, higher standards of care, and more options and choices for our rapidly increasing aging population."

"Old age is a lonely period. At no time in a person's life is kindness so much needed and appreciated. Efficiency is wonderful, but it should never replace kindness.


