Welcome! If you are new in the parish, please introduce yourself after Mass and arrange to register with us; online at www.ckparish.org or in the office during business hours. We're glad you're here!

Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Bride's Room).

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

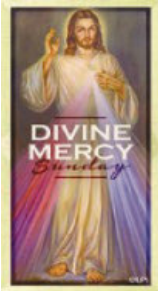

An Item of Information and Interest:

Occasionally the Bishop asks parishes in the diocese to count how many people attend Mass on a weekend. Mass counts were held recently, on March 15/16 or March 22/23.

Christ the King had the largest number of people attending Masses in English: 1838 (we used to be 2000). We also had 319 at our Spanish Mass.

St. Joseph in Kennewick had the highest number of people attending Masses (1615 English, 1215 Spanish), followed by Holy Apostles in East Wenatchee (2300 Spanish, 422 English), then St. Joseph in Yakima (2116 Spanish, 190 English).

Christ the King now has the 4th largest congregation in the diocese.

Easter is celebrated for eight days! Alleluia!

During the Octave of Easter the prayers on Easter Sunday in the Divine Office are prayed on each day of the week through Sunday. Join the Church in celebrating the Resurrection of Christ as we pray the Easter Morning Office antiphons:

1. The splendor of Christ risen from the dead has shone on the people redeemed by his blood, alleluia.
2. Our Redeemer has risen from the tomb; let us sing a hymn of praise to the Lord our God, alleluia.
3. Alleluia, the Lord is risen as he promised, alleluia.

Pray and ponder the following Preface I of Easter:

It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, at all times to acclaim you, O Lord, but on this day above all to laud you yet more gloriously, when Christ our Passover has been sacrificed.

For he is the true Lamb who has taken away the sins of the world; by dying he has destroyed our death and by rising, restored our life.

Therefore, overcome with paschal joy, every land, every people exults in your praise and even the heavenly Powers, with angelic hosts, sing together the unending hymn of your glory, as they acclaim: Holy, Holy, Holy...
